Lots to photograph with many challenges.
















Dick and Charlie's Tea Room - Caddo Lake



Barlett House Malakoff


Acme Brick owner


Abandoned Infantry and Helicopter training base.

Barracks, hospital, firing ranges, landing pads, maintanence...


