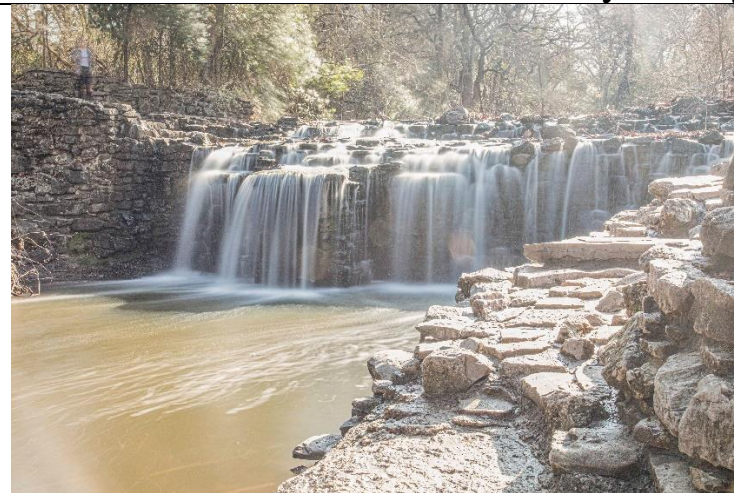
Parking
