




Printing Images with White Backgrounds

- If the background is truly white, no ink will be put down
- Is this OK?
- I say yes.
- But make sure it is truly and uniformly white.
- Might consider and applied border to define the photo edges.

Question:

How to get all photos on one drive
May get new computer. How to move.

Suggestion:

1. Make sure photos from C: and F: plus LR Catalog are on Z: and I:
2. Live with this until new computer

Migration to new computer

- Consider my configuration as a starting point.
- Buy computer with SSD for C: and small or no HDD
- Buy two high quality and performance HDD's – at least 6TB.
- Install 1 of the new HDD's and name F:same as current
- Install Z: in another slot
- Copy photo data to new internal drive and LR Catalog to SSD C:
- Remove Z: and install second new internal HDD
- Start up
- Navigate to the LR catalog and double click to start LR.
- Data from F: should reconnect.
- Data from C: will not be visible. Right click and “Find Folder”
- Within LR, drag data previously on C: to desired folder

Lightroom 11.0 New Release

- The local adjustments have completely changed.
 - Most people suggest MAC users wait
 - Study the new approach before switching for MAC and PC
